B. Find a champion for Hoyt running chair — Dave Graves cited the need for someone to figuratively take the chair under their wing and find pushers and potentially riders.

During the meeting, it was suggested that the City of Brookings Disability Committee be contacted as well as an SDSU student organization who could take on the role of pusher. Other mentioned were Matt Weiss, who serves on the committee, and Mark Sternhagen, who also has been a focal advocate for those with disabilities.
